Chester Music Society is pleased to announce the Chester Young Musicians of the Year competition for 2019, open to instrumentalists and singers up to and including age 18.

Classes: the competition will be open to singers and instrumentalists in three classes:

- Class 1: entrants up to and including age 12 who have achieved minimum grade 3 or equivalent
- Class 2: age 13 to 15, minimum grade 6 or equivalent
- Class 3: age 16 to 18; minimum grade 8 or equivalent

Entrants may submit any instrument of their choice (other than the organ).

The winner in each of the three classes will be further judged for the title of Chester Young Musician of the Year 2019.

Venue: The Competition will be held at the King's School, Wrexham Road, Chester CH4 7QQ.

Date and Time: Sunday 24 November 2019.

Registration from 09.30. Competition to begin at 10.00. Entrants may express a preference for a morning or afternoon performance, but the organisers can give no guarantee. Entrants will be advised of their start time in advance.

Eligibility: entrants must be resident within a 40 mile radius of Chester *a*nd have achieved the age stated on the date of the competition.

Recommendation: Entrants must be recommended by their music teacher, whose details must appear on the application form.

Competition Format: Each entrant will be required to perform a varied programme of their own choice, of which one piece must be performed from memory. Duration: Class 3: 15 minutes; Classes 1 and 2 approximately 10 minutes.

Music: Copies (which may include photocopies) of music to be performed shall be supplied by the entrants free of charge for the use of the adjudicator.

Accompanists: entrants are expected to provide their own accompanist (if required). If you do not have an accompanist, Lauren Turner, an experienced pianist, will be available on the day. Please contact her in good time to arrange rehearsal, fees and repertoire: 07742 587373; *laurenacturner@hotmail.com*

Adjudication: The competition will be judged by local musician and conductor Simon Mercer. The Adjudicator's decision shall be final. The organisers will not enter into correspondence concerning the outcome of the competit*ion*.

A non-refundable application fee of £10 shall be submitted with the application form below.

Awards will be made as follows:

1. For the winner of each class:

• A cash prize of £100

2. For the overall winner and Young Musician of the Year:

- An additional cash prize of $\pounds 250$, and
- A Trophy (to be retained for twelve months)

3. For the winner and the runner up of each class:

• A public performance organised by Chester Music Society at St Mary's Creative Space, Chester on 15 January 2020. (*Participation in this concert is obligatory.*)

Bursaries. Winners and runners-up in Class 3, and the overall Young Musician, will be invited to apply for one of the two Music Society Bursaries, each worth £500. These will be awarded at the Society's discretion to applicants who show outstanding promise and undertake to use them to advance the applicant's musical education.

Closing Date for entries: Friday 8 November 2019. Not later than Friday 15 November entrants must also submit – either by post or email – a brief biography and a schedule of the music to be performed. (Copies of the actual scores for the use of the adjudicator may be brought on the day of the competition.)

In the event that the competition is oversubscribed your name may be added to the waiting list and you will be advised if a place becomes available.

Data Protection. Information and photographs of applicants are kept for the purpose of administration and publicity of this competition and in our database of potential performers in Society events. You have the right to see the information we hold on you, and the right to amend or request deletion of such data on application to the address given below.

Public Admission: The competition on 24 November 2019 and the concert performance on 15 January 2020 will be open to the public. Admission (including competitors' family and supporters) to either event: £5.
